### The Introduction of Recognised Standard 11: Training in Coal Mines

A new recognised standard for Training in Coal Mines has been issued. Standard 11 was gazetted on October 1, 2010 and from that date it has become the new Standard for meeting the health and safety obligations in the coal mining industry in Queensland.

With the introduction of Standard 11 in the coal mining industry, the development of the new GIQ Coal Passport was necessary

### NEW GIQ Coal Passport

GIQ Coal is a new Generic Induction course for anyone working in Queensland in the coal mining industry. It commences on July 1, 2011.

The GIQ Coal course is designed for short term contractors who have current industry experience relevant to their role. Examples of this experience include, but are not limited to, trade experience, heavy industry experience, or mining experience.

Morrissey Group will assist individuals in identifying if they have the required skills and experience prior to enrolment.

Individuals who do not have current industry experience have the option of participating in pre-employment pathway programs to prepare for entry level positions in the resources industry. These programs may include the achievement of a GIQ Coal Passport.

Current GI passport holders can undertake the GIQ Coal Bridging Course to obtain a GIQ Coal passport but **individuals should confirm site requirements with their employer.**

### What's the difference between GI and GIQ Coal?

GIQ Coal is for people seeking employment in the Queensland coal mining industry.

GI is for workers entering the metalliferous mining, heavy industries or the coal mining industry outside of Queensland.

The GIQ Coal course delivers 6 - 7 units of competency whereas the GI course only delivers 2. **This means that the GIQ Coal course will take longer to complete**

**and will cost more.**

### Subjects in the NEW GIQ Coal Passport

#### Surface

- RIIOHS201A - Work safely and follow OHS policies and procedures
- RIIERR205A - Apply initial response first aid
- RIIGOV201A - Comply with site work processes/procedures
- RIIRIS201A - Conduct local risk control
- RIICOM201A - Communicate in the workplace
- RIIERR302A - Respond to local emergencies and incidents.

#### Additional unit for Underground

- RIIERR203A - Escape from a hazardous situation unaided.

## MARYBOROUGH OFFICE
